Funding available to all agencies located within District 2 North Delta Law Enforcement Planning District.

Notice is hereby given of the availability of federal funds through the Office for Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention housed in the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs. The goal is to improve juvenile justice systems by increasing the availability and types of prevention and intervention programs and juvenile justice system improvements. Eligible applicants are units of general local government or combinations, local private agencies, and Indian tribes that perform law enforcement functions (as determined by the Secretary of the Interior) and that agree to comply with the requirements specified in paragraphs (11), (12), and (13) of the JJDP Act, applicable to the detention and confinement of juveniles. The Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement administers and allocates these funds through the North Delta Law Enforcement Planning District, Inc.

As per JJDP Advisory Board regulations, NDLEPD will only allocate one project for FY2023 in the amount of \$43,048.00 and one project for FY2024 in the amount of \$41,222.00. Each year's project will be funded for a 12 month period, unless the JJDP Advisory Board approves an alternate project length. Any agency which applies for JJDP funding must have a current UEI Central Contractor Registration number. The applicant who receives FY23 funding may also be eligible for two additional years of funding.

ALL PROJECT REQUESTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY 10 AM - Monday, July 6, 2026
